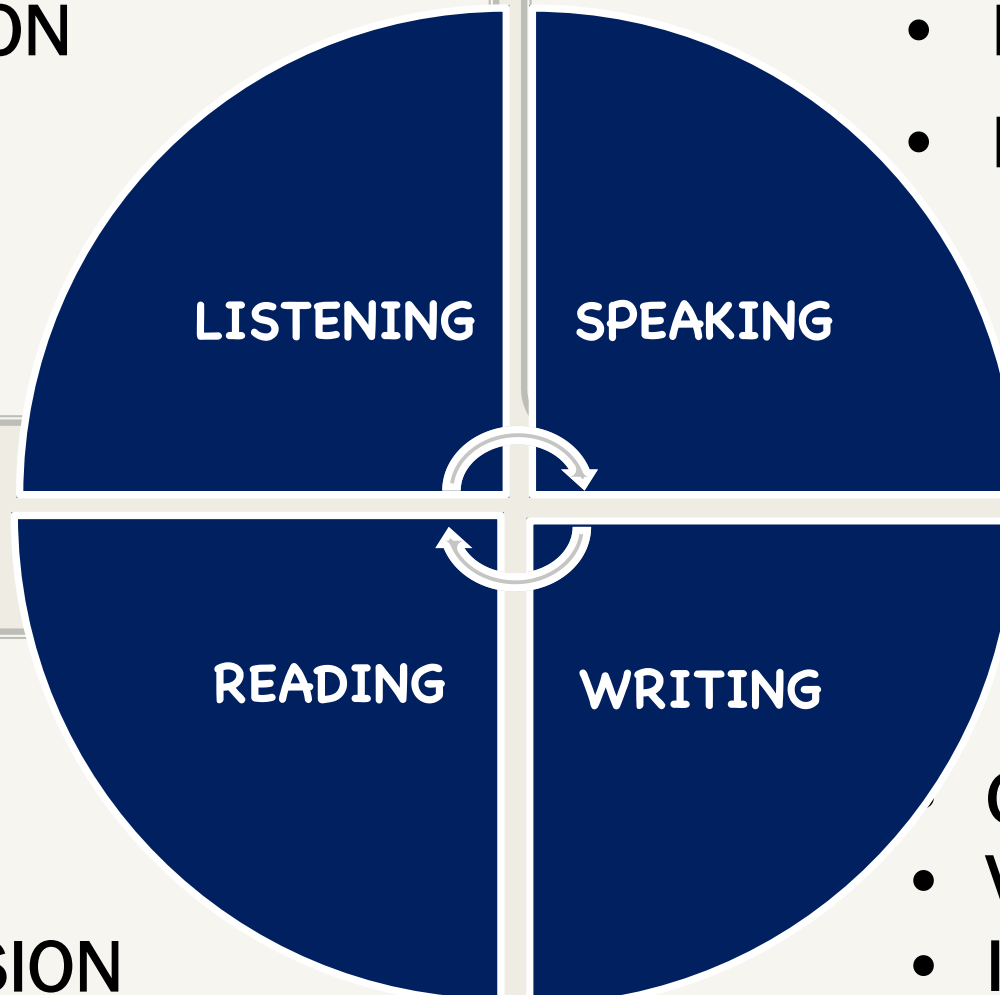



Let's take a careful look at the following words:
✓ Pronounce (v): spelled with "ou" in the second syllable.
✓ Pronunciation (n): spelled with "u" in the second syllable.

Note: Pronunciation is not spelled correctly and pronounce is not a real word.

The different between P sound and B sound

Voiced: "B" has voice
Unvoiced: "P" has air



See how the lips are pressed together
Watch that the vocal cords vibrate for /b/

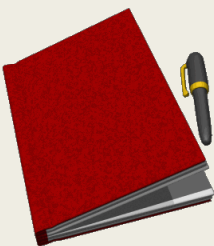

PRONUNCIATION COURSE

WHAT IS PRONUNCIATION?

- *The way in which a language or a particular word or sound is pronounced (Oxford dictionary).*
- To be more understandable in communication, learners should cover all aspects of pronunciation such as intonation, phrasing, stress, timing, rhythm, voice quality, attention to gestures and expressions when speaking.



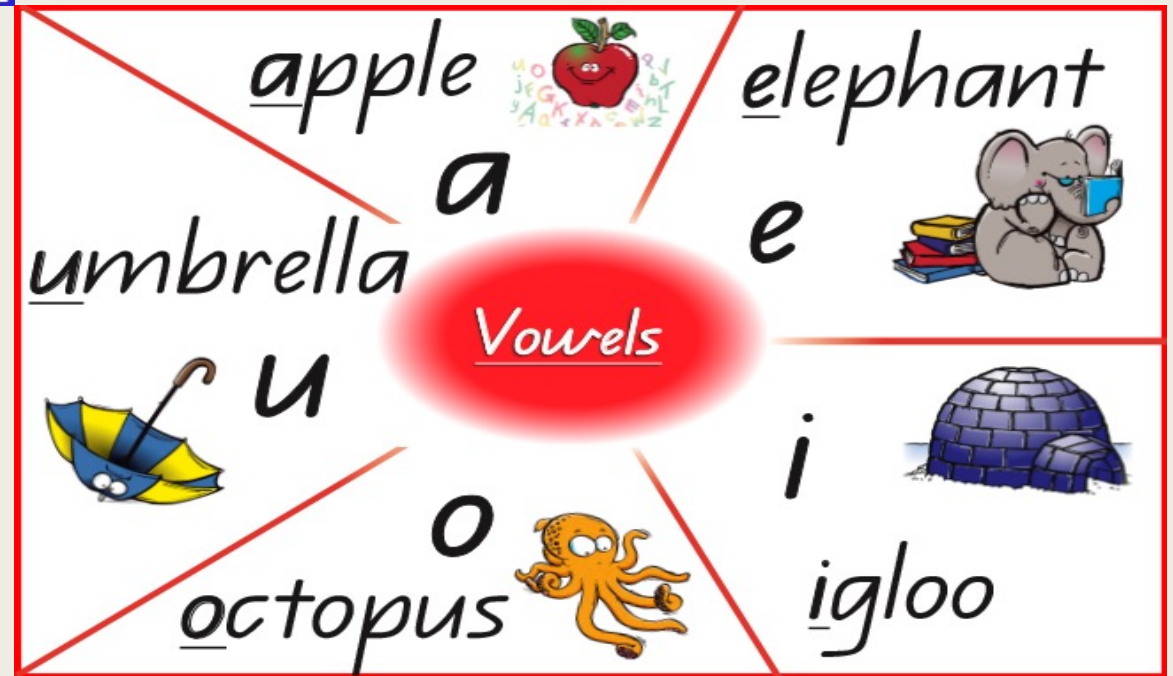
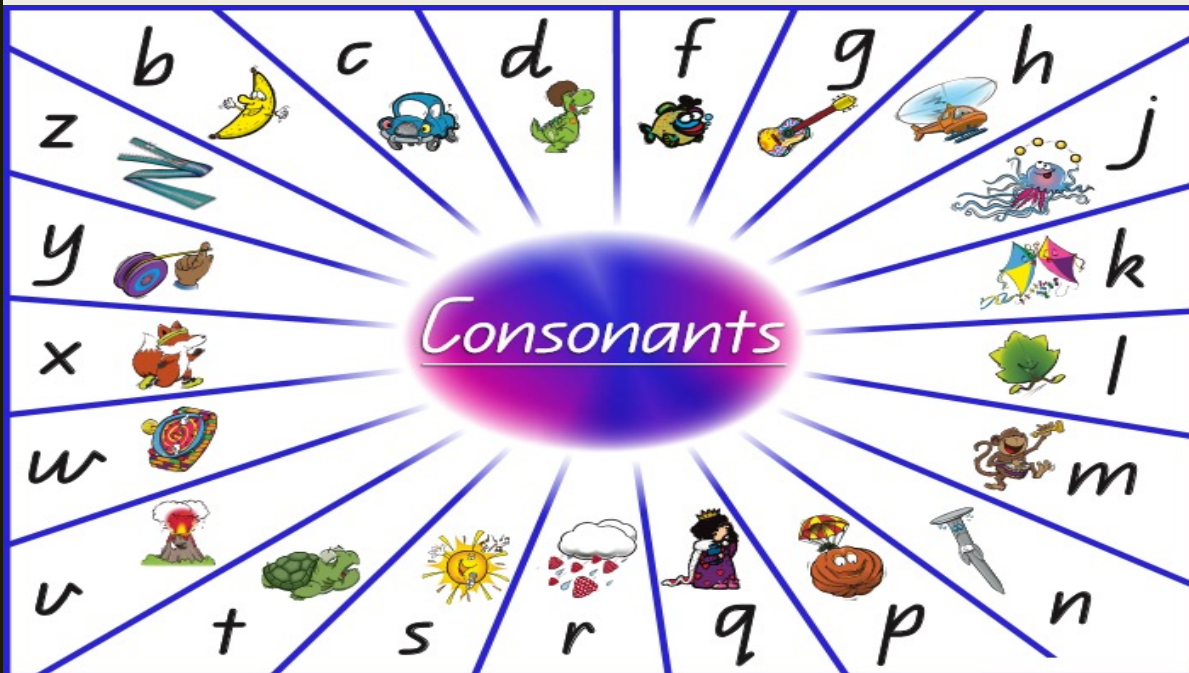
WHY IS PRONUNCIATION IMPORTANT?

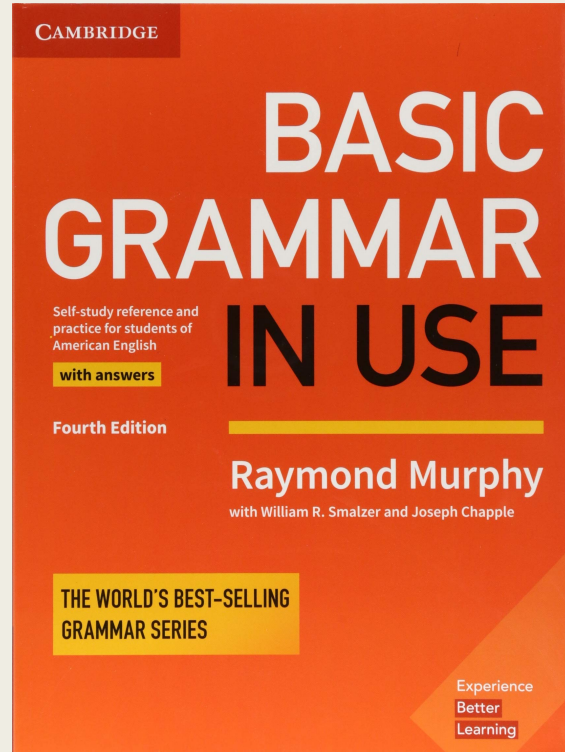
- “Learners with good pronunciation in English are more likely to be understood even if they make errors in other areas, whereas learners whose pronunciation is difficult to understand will not be understood, even if their grammar is perfect!” (Adult Migrant English Program Research Centre, 2002)



ENGLISH PRONUNCIATION COURSE

- This course is slightly different from other courses, moving from intermediate to easy and then advanced levels. Learners start first with medium consonants – easier vowels – more difficult consonants. It has **15 LESSONS** with mainly **50 SOUNDS** in total.
- **Lesson 1 – lesson 5:** popular Consonants in order (P – B, F- V, L, R, S – SH)
- **Lesson 6 – lesson 7:** 20 vowel sounds
- **Lesson 8 – lesson 11:** (/W/- /KW/ - /GW/ - /Z/ - /J/, M - N - NG /ŋ/- /ndʒ/ - /ŋg/ - /ks / - /g'z/, H – CH, K – G)
- **Lesson 12 – lesson 15:** more difficult consonants (T – D, TH /θ/, TH /ð/, /ʒ/ vs /dʒ/)

GRAMMAR COURSE

WHAT IS GRAMMAR?

- The rules in a language for changing the form of words and joining them into sentences (*Oxford dictionary*).
- Grammar explains the forms and structure of words (called morphology) and how they are arranged in sentences (called syntax). In other words, grammar provides the rules for common use of both spoken and written language so we can more easily understand each other.



WHY IS GRAMMAR IMPORTANT?

- **Grammar** is important because it provides information that helps the reader's comprehension. It is the structure that conveys precise meaning from the writer to the audience.
- While it can be argued that good grammar knowledge will not necessarily make you a better writer, it is recognized that it will help make you a more effective writer. Good grammar knowledge enables you as a writer to understand what makes a piece of writing successful, so that it will capture both the interest and understanding of the reader.
